

Warrant of arrest on failure to surrender to bail under s. 5(4) Backing of Warrants (Republic of Ireland) Act 1865

(Criminal Procedure Rules, r 17.11(1))

In the [county of . Petty Sessional Division of].

To each and all of the constables of .

A.B. (hereinafter called the defendant) was on the day of , 19 , ordered by the Magistrates' Court sitting at to be delivered at some convenient point of departure from England or Wales into the custody of a member of the police force of the Republic of Ireland [or brought before the Magistrates' Court sitting at pursuant to a provisional warrant of arrest issued under section 4 of the Backing of Warrants (Republic of Ireland) Act 1965]:

And the defendant was released, in pursuance of section 5 of the Backing of Warrants (Republic of Ireland) Act 1965, upon a recognisance conditioned for his/her surrender to the police officer in charge of the police station on the day of , 19 , at the hour of in the noon:

And, in breach of the said recognisance, the defendant has failed to surrender as aforesaid:

You are hereby commanded to bring the defendant before the police officer in charge of the police station forthwith.
