NOTES

- A. Includes the posts of President, Asylum and Immigration Tribunal and President, Employment Appeals Tribunal, both of whom are High Court Judges.
- B. Part-time position. Salary for 3 day week is pro-rata to Group 5 rate.
- C. All four offices currently held by the same person. Current incumbent (as at 1/4/09) paid at Group 4 rate.
- D. Under an arrangement established in April 2002 the current post-holder receives a salary of 108% of the Group 5 rate.
- E. Chancery, Mercantile and Patents Judges.
- F. Post holders are paid the salary for Group 5 so long as they are required to carry out significantly different work from their counterparts elsewhere in the UK.
- G. Current post-holder receives a salary of 110% of Group 7 rate.
- H. 108% of the Group 7 rate. In addition, the former Deputy Chief Asylum Support Adjudicator and Designated Immigration Judges in London and London Group 7 posts will continue to attract a London salary lead of £2,000 p.a. and a London Allowance of £2000 pa.
- I. £4,000 of this figure is designated as London Weighting.
