



155th UPDATE – PRACTICE DIRECTION AMENDMENTS

The amendments to Practice Direction 27B – Claims Under the Pre-Action Protocol For Personal Injury Claims Below the Small Claims Limit in Road Traffic Accidents – Court Procedure, which supplements the Civil Procedure Rules 1998, are made by the Master of the Rolls under the powers delegated to him by the Lord Chief Justice under Schedule 2, Part 1, paragraph 2(2) of the Constitutional Reform Act 2005, and is approved by Lord Bellamy KC, Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State for Justice, by the authority of the Lord Chancellor.

The amendments to Practice Direction 27B come into force on 6 March 2023.

PRACTICE DIRECTION 27B – CLAIMS UNDER THE PRE-ACTION PROTOCOL FOR PERSONAL INJURY CLAIMS BELOW THE SMALL CLAIMS LIMIT IN ROAD TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS – COURT PROCEDURE

- 1) In Appendix C to the Practice Direction, in Table B (1) and Table C, in the second column of both tables, omit the entry “**DO NOT** include details of any offers made by the compensator or the claimant that have not been accepted”.
