PRACTICE DIRECTION 36H – PILOT SCHEME: PROCEDURE FOR SERVICE OF CERTAIN PROTECTION ORDERS ON THE POLICE

(1) In paragraph 1.3(c), for “26 July 2019” substitute “26 July 2020”.

PRACTICE DIRECTION 36K – PILOT SCHEME: PROCEDURE FOR THE BULK SCANNING OF CERTAIN PRIVATE LAW APPLICATIONS

(1) In paragraph 5.1-

(a) in paragraph 8.6B of Practice Direction 12B as modified, for “paragraph 8.6C” substitute “paragraphs 8.6C and 8.6DA”; and

(b) after paragraph 8.6D of Practice Direction 12B as modified insert-

“**8.6DA** Paragraph 8.6B(2) (Neopost emailing to Cafcass) does not apply where the application is to be filed at a family court location which has been specified to Neopost by Her Majesty’s Courts and Tribunals Service as one where C100 application packs should not be emailed to Cafcass.”.
