TROWBRIDGE COUNTY COURT AND BURTON UPON TRENT COUNTY COURT.

1. This Direction is given by Peter Handcock, Chief Executive of Her Majesty's Courts and Tribunals Service, on behalf of the Lord Chancellor after consulting the Lord Chief Justice in accordance with section 2(3) of the County Courts Act 1984. It has effect from 25th March 2013, which is the date when each court ceases to be held.

Burton upon Trent County Court – ceases to be held as of 24th March 2013

2. The district previously served by Burton upon Trent County Court is divided between Leicester, Nuneaton County Court, Stafford County Court, Stoke on Trent County Court and Walsall County Court as follows:

Leicester County Court takes on the localities of Annswell, Appleby Magna, Ashby de la Zouch, Blackfordby, Calke, Chilcote, Coleorton, Donisthorp, Heather, Moira, New Packington, Newton Burgoland, Normanton le Heath, Oakthorpe, Packington, Ravenstone, Shellbrook, Smisby, Snarestone, Swebstone and Willesley.

Nuneaton County Court takes on the localities of Alvecote, Amington, Bangley, Belgrave, Bodymoor Heath, Bolehall, Bonehill, Cliff, Clifton Campville, Croxall, Dosthill, Drayton Bassett, Edingale, Fazeley, Glascote, Harlaston, Haunton, Hockley, Hunts Green, Kettlebrook, Measham, Middleton, Mile Oak, Newton Regis, No Man's Heath, Seckington, Shuttington, Stonydelph, Tamworth, Thorpe Constantine, Two Gates, Whateley Wiggington and Wilnecote.

Stafford County Court takes on the localities of Abbots Bromley, Admaston, Blithfield, Bramshall, Bromley Hurst, Bromley Park, Bromley Wood, Dapple Heath, Draycott in the Clay, Gratwich, Hoar Cross, Kingstone, Loxley, Newborough, Newton and Willslock.

Stoke on Trent County Court takes on the localities of Blounts Green, Crakemarsh, Creighton, Denstone, Fole, Gorsty Hill, Highwood, Marchington, Marchington Cliff, Netherland Green, Rocester, Smallwood, Spath, Stramshall and Uttoxeter.

Walsall County Court takes on the localities of Alrewas, Alrewas Hayes, Bassetts Pole, Canwell, Comberford, Elford, Fisherwick, Fradley, Freeford,

Haselour, Hints, Hopwas, Huddlesford, Kings Bromley, Orgreave, Packington, Swinfen, Whittington, Whittington Hurst and Yoxall.

Derby County Court takes on the remainder of the localities previously comprising the district of Burton Upon Trent County Court.

Trowbridge County Court – ceases to be held as of 24th March 2013

3. The district previously served by Trowbridge County Court is divided between Bath County Court, Chippenham and Trowbridge County Court, Salisbury County Court and Yeovil County Court as follows:

Bath County Court takes on the localities of Babbington; Batcombe; Boreham; Buckland Dinham; Burton; Coleford; Corsley; Downhead; East Cranmore; Horningsham; Leigh On Mendip; Mells; Nunney; Oakhill; Stoke St Michael; Trudox Hill; Vobster; Wanstrow; Westcombe; Witham Friary.

Salisbury County Court takes on the localities of Ashton; Ashton Gifford; Bishopstrow; Cortington; Corton; Crockerton; Deverills; Heytesbury; Hill Deverill; Imber; Kingston Deverill; Leys Green; Longbridge Deverill; Norton Bavant; Norton Ferris; Sutton Veny; Tytherington.

Yeovil County Court takes on the localities of Kilmington; Lower Whitbourne; Maiden Bradley.


Chippenham and Trowbridge County Court takes on the remainder of the localities previously comprising the district of Trowbridge County Court.
